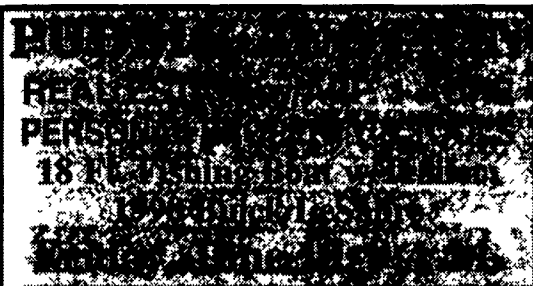
## MARTIN SALE
