ST. BONIFACE

June 5 marks the feast day of St. Boniface (c. 675), the English monk called the Apostle of Germany, an Anglo-Saxon whose name was originally Winfrid. (Lest you are confused, there were several Bonifaces: saints, popes, generals, and ministers.) In old England, Boniface came to mean any good-tempered soul or jolly landlord, and "St. Boniface's cup" was that extra glass of spirits offered as a toast to the health of the current pope. This Boniface was not one to encourage sobriety or extreme piety, but as a landlord, he may have been a model of generosity and good faith.

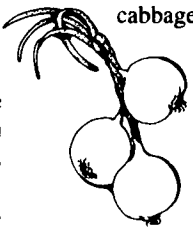
TIP OF THE WEEK

Use a hanging plant pot (with drainage holes) for outdoor clothespin storage.

CARAWAY & RED CABBAGE

- 1/4 cup (1/2 stick) butter
- 1 red onion, sliced
- 2 teaspoons caraway seeds
- 1 head (about 2 pounds) red cabbage
- 1/4 cup sugar (or less, to taste)
- 1/3 cup red wine vinegar

then add to pot and cook until soft, about 5 minutes. Mix sugar in vinegar, and pour over cabbage. Cook about another 5 minutes, or until cabbage is tender.



Makes 8 servings.

Melt butter in a large pot and add onion and caraway seeds, sautéing about 3 minutes. Core and slice cabbage.

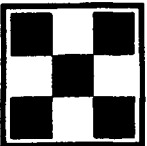

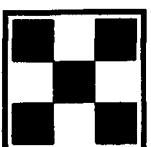
