

# MACCA Exam Deadline Nears

EDGEWATER, Md. — The sign-up deadline for the Mid-Atlantic Certified Crop Adviser (MACCA) exam to be held in this region on Friday, August 7, 1998 is fast approaching.

All registration forms for the exams which will be held at the Holiday Inn Monticello, Charlottesville, Virginia, but be received by June 26, 1998.

The Mid-Atlantic Certified Crop Adviser Board has been established for New Jersey, Delaware, Maryland, Virginia, and West Virginia.

The Certified Crop Adviser (CCA) program is a nationally recognized, voluntary certification program developed through the collaborative efforts of the public sector and the agricultural industry to ensure high standards for crop advisers.

It is intended for anyone who

makes nutrient, pesticide, crop, or environmental recommendations to producers, including dealers, distributors, applicators, consultants, manufacturers, allied industries, and state and federal agency personnel.

To date over 214 individuals have passed the rigorous 6 hours of exams and become certified.

The CCA program is administered by state or regional boards in association with the American Society of Agronomy, which handles similar programs for specialists in agronomy, crop consulting, weed science and other agricultural disciplines.

To become Mid-Atlantic CCA certified, an applicant must:

- have at least two years of crop advising experience with a bachelor's of science degree in agriculture, three years of crop

advising experience with an associate degree in agriculture, or have a minimum of four years of crop advising experience post high school;

- provide employer and client references;

- pass a national and the two MACCA regional exams; and

- sign a code of ethics.
- To remain certified, a member must participate in 40 hours of continuing education over a two year period with a minimum of 10 hours in any other year, and undergo an audit biannually by the MACCA Board to verify continuing education and adherence to the code of ethics.

The deadline for the August 7, 1998 exam is June 26, 1998.

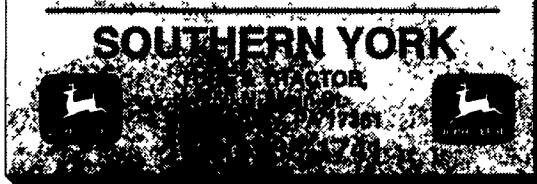

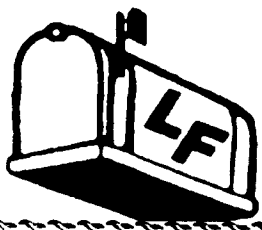
