June 15 Deadline

POTTSVILLE (Schuylkill Co.) — The Schuylkill County office of the USDA Farm Service Agency is reminding farmers that June 15 is the deadline to report crop acreage in order to remain eligible to participate in a variety of federal programs.

The agency's reminder applies statewide.

"Acreage reporting ... is a step in the right direction for farmers striving to achieve the best possible farm management techniques," according to the USDA FSA news release.

Reporting is required for those

who participate in the commodity loan program or the 10-year Conservation Reserve Program (CRP), as well as those who intend to or have planted fruits or vegetables on land included in the seven-year flexibility program.

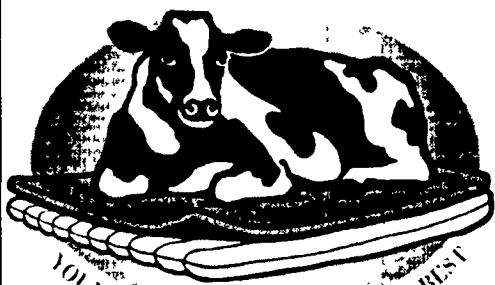
The deadline for reporting planted small grain acreages is June 15.

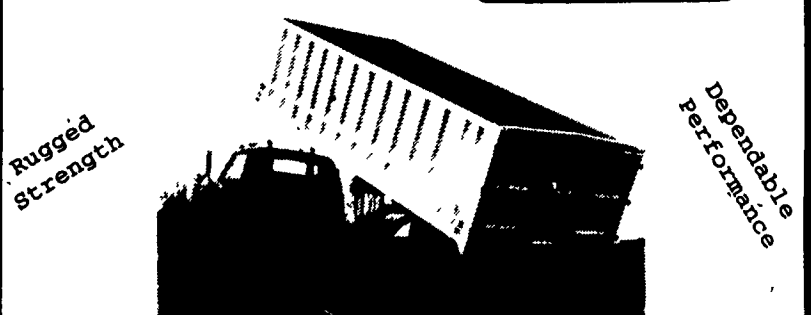
