'Pedal To Preserve' Bike Tour Benefits Lancaster Farmland Trust

LANCASTER (Lancaster Co.) — Lancaster Farmland Trust's second *Pedal to Preserve* bicycle tour will be held on Saturday, June 20. The tour accommodates both leisure and competitive cyclists, offering both an 18-mile and 39-mile ride through some of western Lancaster County's most beautiful farmland. This year's ride begins and ends at Donegal High School, Mount Joy, and showcases more than a dozen farms that have been forever pre-

served from development.

Registration is \$20 in advance or \$25 on ride day; advance registrants receive event T-shirts. Families are encouraged to ride along with WGAL anchorperson Brad Hicks — the honorary chairman of *Pedal to Preserve*. Children 12 and under ride free when accompanied by adults. Riders may also win prizes by obtaining pledge sponsorships. *Pedal to Preserve* attracted
