Oklahoma National Stockyards - Weekly Cattle Summary

Compared to last week: Feeder cattle steady with moderate demand. Stocker steers and steer calves 2.00-8.00 lower with greatest decline on 4 wt calves. Stocker heifers steady but light calves 4.00 lower. Demand for calves and stockers continues light. Farmer interest nil as wheat harvest progresses. Also dry conditions in south Central Oklahoma hindering development of crab grass pastures. Quality average. Feeder cattle in mostly medium flesh, end moderately fleshy. Flesh condition over past few weeks as farmers held cattle in hopes of a better market. Weigh-ups average to full. Slaughter cows 1.00 lower. Slaughter bulls steady. Packer demand light to moderate. Demand from south Texas packers continues light due to drought conditions. Total cows and bulls 670 with half to packers. Receipts this

week 10,200; last week 16,969; last year 12,125. Supply consisted of 79 percent yearlings over 600 lbs; 15 percent calves; 6 percent cows and bulls of which half went to slaughter. Prices follow with weighted average weight and price in parenthesis.
