

#### PEACHES & BERRIES

- 6 peaches
- 2 lemons, cut into wedges 2 pints blackberries
- 2 pints strawberries (or
- rasoberries)
- 1/2 cup honey
- 1 teaspoon ground cardamom

oil a large pot of water and blanch the peaches for about 30 seconds, or until skins loosen Rinse with cool water, drain, and peel Halve and pit peaches and place two halves on each of six

plates Sprinkle peaches with lemon juice, reserving some wedges for garnish Wash and hull the berries and let them dry Combine honey and cardamom, pour over berries, and stir gently. Fill each peach half with some of the berry mixture and serve with lemon wedges


