CURRYVILLE (Blair Co.) — Seventeen-year-old Amanda Sollenberger, daughter of Gerald and Jean Sollenberger of Curryville, was crowned at the 1998-99 Blair County Dairy Princess recently at the Logan Valley Mall, Altoona. Sollenberger will be assisted in her reign by alternate Heather Brennamen, 16-year-old daughter of Kenneth and Elizabeth Brennamen of Williamsburg.

The pageant was held on the center stage of the Logan Valley Mall in front of a crowd of 175 people. State Representative Jerry Stern was the master of ceremonies for the evening. Each contestant presented an original skit promoting milk and dairy products to the crowd. Before the pageant began the contestants each had an interview with the three judges.

Amanda Sollenberger's presentation was a delightful version of the "Tooth Fairy" warning against poor nutrition and presenting the benefits of milk and dairy products to children's teeth as well as their overall health. Amanda will be a senior

at Central High School in the fall where she is enrolled in the English honors classes, agriculture and the college preparatory track.
