Size of Business vs. Margin of Profit - Article 5

The last article looked at how farming methods can affect farm profits. This week we will focus on size of business and its impact on farm profits and profit margins

Consider what size business you are capable of managing As you get larger, remember you start managing more people, and you manage them differently than cows

Getting better before getting bigger has many advantages, especially when cash flow and equity are limited. It requires less capital, it is less risky, and a smaller operation is easier to manage.

Well-managed smaller farms, with larger margins of profit per cwt of milk, may be able to survive economic downtums better than a larger farm operating with a smaller margin of profit Note larger tarms don't necessarily have smaller margins of profit However, smaller margin of profit may result because of a recent expansion that involves larger debt payments See Table 1

In this example, both farms had the same original profit of \$30,000. Then, milk price dropped \$1.00 per cwt The larger farm experienced a larger drop (\$18,000 vs \$9,000) because it had more cwt 's of milk to take the hit Consequently, the larger farm ended up with less profit (\$12,000 vs \$21,000) A second \$1 00 drop would send the larger farm into a \$6,000 loss (\$12,000 - \$18,000), while the smaller farm would still have \$12,000 profit (\$21,000 - \$9,000) Conversely, if milk prices increase the larger tarm would experience a greater increase in profit

Getting better might be more profitable than expanding -- at east until the expansion loans are paid off Situations will vary a lot from farm to farm, so push the pencol and use your own figures. The main point is consider profit margins as well as size, try not to let profit margins shrink to the point where you become extremely vulnerable to even the slightest changes in costs (i.e. feed) or returns (i.e. milk prices) If you do expand, get better before gettin bigger, and be sure you are capable of managing a larger
