

Agricultural Preservation Board Approves Farmland

HARRISBURG (Dauphin Co.) — The Agricultural Land Preservation Board has approved easement purchases for seven farms across the commonwealth, Agriculture Secretary Samuel E. Hayes Jr. recently announced.

"Gov. Tom Ridge is committed to the protection of farmland across the state to ensure the strength of Pennsylvania's agriculture industry for future generations," said Hayes, who chairs the Agricultural Land Preservation Board.

The board also supported the state Agriculture Department's submission of a proposal to the U.S. Department of Agriculture's Natural Resources Conservation Service (NRCS) for \$2.89 million in federal funding for farmland preservation in Pennsylvania. If secured, the federal funding

would assist in the preservation of 31 farms in 18 counties, totaling 4,663 acres. In two previous rounds, the state Department of Agriculture secured \$1.27 million in additional funding from NRCS.

Created in 1989, the Pennsylvania Agricultural Land Preservation Board is responsible for the oversight of the state Farmland Preservation Program. It allows the state and counties to purchase development rights, referred to as easements, to guarantee that farms will remain as agricultural land.

Including three county-owned easements accepted today, the Farmland Preservation Program has protected 938 farms in 39 counties encompassing 118,873 acres.
