Demand was light to instances good, mostly moderate with food service and features best. Supplies were at least adequate or available, except jumbos and extra large remained occasionally tight. Breaking stock supplies were adequate to ample for the light demand. Light type hen offerings were sufficient for full slaughter schedules.

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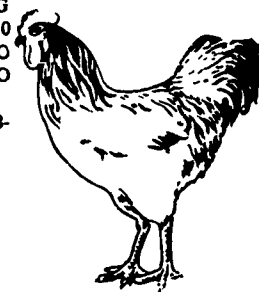


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
