**BASTILLE DAY**

July 14 marks the national holiday of the republic of France, something like our Independence Day. In 1789, a mob of Parisians stormed the fortress prison Bastille in Paris, looking to capture ammunitions stored there. The prison, which had once housed the Man with the Iron Mask and Voltaire, had no political prisoners at that time, although there were seven inmates who gained their freedom that day. The event was symbolic in the French Revolution, however, and led the way for further rebellions.

**MOCHA CAKE**

- 1/2 cup (1 stick) butter
  - 1/2 cup sugar
  - 2 large eggs
  - 6 tablespoons flour
  - 7 tablespoons cornstarch
  - 1-1/2 tablespoons powdered instant coffee
  - 2 tablespoons brewed coffee
- Glaze:  
 2 ounces sweet chocolate  
 2 tablespoons brewed coffee

ingredients and stir into the butter mixture. Add brewed coffee and mix. Bake in a greased and floured 8-inch square pan for 30 minutes at 350° F. While cake is cooling, heat chocolate and coffee for glaze in a double boiler. When cake is cool, pour warm glaze over cake.

Makes 1 8-inch cake.

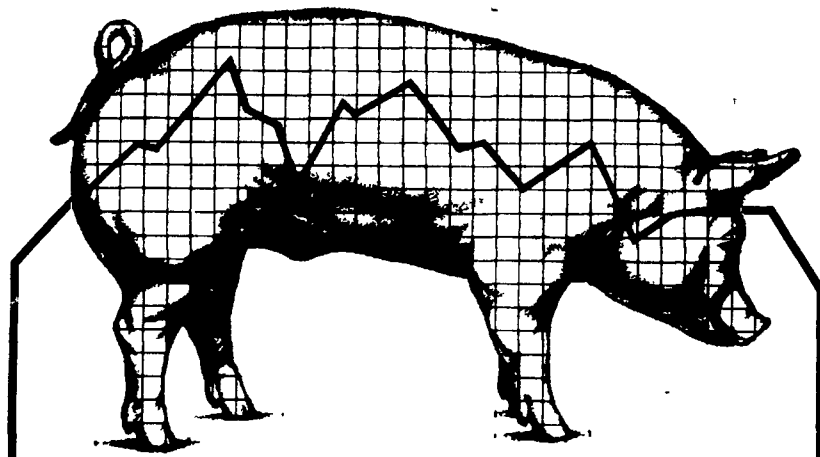

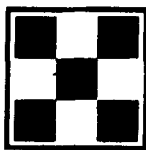
