USDA Grants Gov. Ridge's Request For Disaster Declaration

HARRISBURG (Dauphin Co.)
— Gov. Tom Ridge announced that the USDA has granted his request to declare a major disaster for farmers in four Pennsylvania counties.

Family farmers in Allegheny, Berks, Somerset, and Wyoming countries are eligible to apply for federal disaster aid, including Farm Service Agency (FSA) emergency loans.

Ridge made the request for disaster assistance because of the severe storms, tornadoes, and flooding that damaged these counties on May 31 through June 2, 1998. Gov. Ridge's request for farm assistance was made in conjunction with his general disaster relief request to President Clinton on June 3.

"We are very pleased that the request for assistance to the commonwealth's number one industry has been approved," Ridge said. "This has been a very difficult planting season for Pennsylvania farmers, and the official declaration from the USDA will offer

some support for our struggling farmers."

In addition to the above counties, 19 other Pennsylvania counties are named as contiguous counties where eligible family farmers also may qualify for FSA emergency loan assistance. The eligible counties are Armstrong, Beaver, Bedford, Bradford, Butler, Cambria, Chester, Fayette, Lackawanna, Lancaster, Lebanon, Lehigh, Luzerne, Montgomery, Schuylkill, Sullivan, Susquehanna, Washington, and Westmore-

land

Emergency loan applications will be accepted through Feb. 8, 1999, for physical and productive losses. The current interest rate is 3.75 percent

Damage assessment reports were completed and confirmed by the Pennsylvania Agricultural Statistics Service and the State Emer-

gency Board, based on information from county emergency boards.
