— Following a threatening wind and thunderstorm the sun emerged from behind the clouds to create a perfect evening for the annual agricultural parade. The parade is held in conjunction with the Martinsburg July 4th activities.

For nearly two hours farm equipment both antique and new, clowns, bands, majorette groups, llamas, horses, pony carts, floats with various local queens and princesses, and fire trucks paraded along the street from Ritchey's Dairy to the Johnson Memorial Park.
