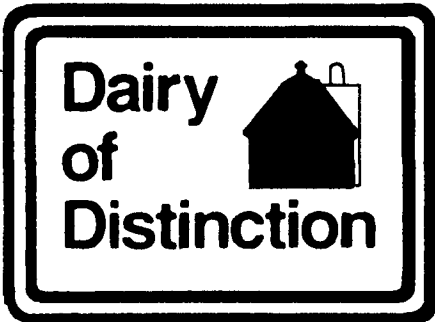


BODENDALE FARM



Robert and Brenda Book farm 100 acres along Strasburg Road in Lancaster County. Under the Bodendale prefix they milk 36 cows in a conventional barn and have a corresponding number of calves and helpers. For Robert, a good feeding program is most important and they use a TMR mix of haylage, high moisture corn, and silage. The herd average is 20,000 pounds of milk.

Robert sees the future of dairy farming in "bigness." Small operations continue to have a hard time. But he said the milk prices have been better this year. And the new jump in price for June and July is a welcome relief after last year. Brenda gets the credit for keeping this new Dairy of Distinction looking nice.

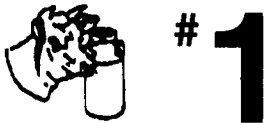

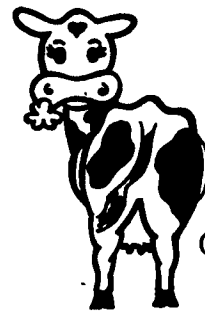
