Slaughter cow trading was active with prices ranging 1.00-2.00 higher and instances 2.50 higher on the leanest (85-90 percent) cows. Slaughter bulls sold 1.00-2.00 lower than Monday. Supply included 40 percent slaughter steers and 42 percent slaugher cows.

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
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
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
