IN PHILADELPHIA, PRICES FOR EXTRA LARGE AND LARGE WERE UNCHANGED TO THREE CENTS HIGHER AND MEDIUMS WERE UNCHANGED TO ONE CENT HIGHER. IN BOSTON, EXTRA LARGE PRICES WERE UNCHANGED TO TWO CENTS HIGHER, LARGE WERE UNCHANGED TO THREE CENTS HIGHER, AND MEDIUMS WERE UNCHANGED. PRICES IN NEW ENGLAND WERE THREE CENTS HIGHER FOR EXTRA LARGE AND LARGE, TWO CENTS HIGHER FOR MEDIUMS AND SMALLS, AND JUMBOS WERE UNCHANGED. THE MARKET TONE

WAS FULLY STEADY TO FIRM. DEMAND WAS LIGHT TO GOOD, BETTER INTO RESORT AREAS AND WHERE FUTURES WERE IN PROGRESS. SUPPLIES OF THE LARGER SIZES REMAINED TIGHT WHILE THE LIGHTER WEIGHTS WERE BARELY ADEQUATE TO ADEQUATE. BREAKING STOCK SUPPLIES WERE USUALLY ADEQUATE FOR THE LIGHT DEMAND. OFFERINGS OF SPENT HENS WERE SUFFICIENT FOR FULL PROCESSING SCHEDULES.

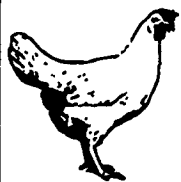

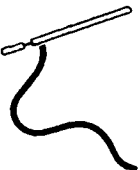
