Simple Stir-Fry Sauce

- % cups chicken broth
- 2 tablespoons soy sauce
- 1/2 teaspoon sugar

2 teaspoons cornstarch mixed with 1 tablespoon water Heat until thick stirring constantly. Does not make much. I usually double or triple if using with meat and vegetables.

ANSWER — A reader wanted to know how to make baking powder, cake flour, etc. Thanks to a New York reader for sending the following recipes.

Baking Powder (Single Acting)

- 2 teaspoons cream of tartar
- 1 teaspoon bicarbonate of baking soda
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 1/2 teaspoon cornstarch

For every cup of flour in your recipe, sift all ingredients together twice then add flour

Once mixed, this doesn't store well. Works fine to mix and use right away if you run out of store purchased variety.

Quick Brown Sugar

- ½ cup white granulated sugar
- 2 tablespoons unsulfured molasses
- Blend sugar and molasses. Yield is the same as ½ cup brown sugar.

Cake Flour

For each cup cake flour, put 2 tablespoons cornstarch into 1 cup measuring cup. Spoon in enough flour to reach the 1 cup mark; sift together three-times.

Four cups cake flour: Combine 3½ cups unsifted allpurpose flour with ½ cup cornstarch. Sift together 4 or 5 times. Store in an airtight container. Use in any recipe calling for cake flour.

Unsweetened Baker's Chocolate

When you need unsweetened baker's chocolate for cooking and you only have unsweetened cocoa powder, blend three tablespoons cocoa powder with 1 tablespoon sweet butter. Makes 1 ounce equivalent to 1 square baking chocolate.

Self Rising Flour

- 8 cups all-purpose flour
- 5 tablespoons baking powder
- 2 tablespoons sugar
- 1 tablespoon salt

Combine ingredients and sift together 3 times. Store in a well-sealed plastic bag until ready to use.


