

1574 697 239 231 CATTLE: Compared to Tuesday; a good offering of slaughter steers sold steady to firm, instances .50 higher. Holstein steers and slaughter heifers were mostly steady. The quality, as a whole, was much improved from last week and most of the cattle were sold in good sized uniform bunches. Lean slaughter cows sold mostly steady to .50 higher, while the fleshier cows (less than 85 percent lean) were mostly 1.00 higher. Slaughter bulls were steady. Supply included 52 percent slaughter steers and 34 percent slaughter cows.

CALVES: Compared to Monday's auction, veal calves sold 7.00-8.00 lower with fewer light-weight calves selling for yeal. Larger slaughter calves were fully steady in a good offering. Holstein bull calves returning to the farm sold mostly 10.00 higher in active trading. Holstein heifer demand was excellent and prices were as much as 80.00 higher than Monday's light test. Around 85 percent of supply returned to the farm.

VEALERS: Good and Choice 70-110 lbs 20.00-26.00. Standard and low Good 60-90 lbs 15.00-20.00. Few Utiltiy down to 11.00.

SLAUGHTER CALVES: Good and Choice 200-350 lbs 70.00-85.00. Few Standard and low Good 250-400 lbs 50.00-65.00.
