## Lancaster 4-H'ers Hold Fashion Revue

LANCASTER (Lancaster Co.) - Katie Ranck, Leola; Carrie Singleton, New Holland; Tanya Aument, Quarryville; and Holly Hoover, Ephrata, will participate in the State 4-H Fashion Revue to be held on August 5, at Eisenhower Auditorium on the University Park Campus of Penn State University, as part of Penn State Achievement Days.

The theme of this year's pro-

gram is "Picture Perfect." As finalists from the Capital Region Fashion Revue held July 9, in Harrisburg, Katie, Carrie, Tanya and Holly will compete with 60 other 4-H'ers for a place in the state honors group. At the state revue, a panel of professional judges selects 10 finalists. The entrants are judged on garment construction, fit, degree of construction difficulty, appropriateness of garment for 4-H'er and modeling ability.

By participating in the series of county, regional, and state revues, 4-H textiles and science project members have a chance to turn self-consciousness into self-confidence. They learn about wardrobe selection, the importance of good posture, physical fitness and other aspects of grooming. Penn State's Cooperative Extension coordinates the 4-H program in Pennsylvania.
