Compared to last week: Feeder steers and heifers steady. Steer calves steady. Heifer calves steady to 2.00 higher. Demand good. Weigh-ups average to mostly full. Quality plain to average, few attractive calves. Feeder cattle in thin to medium flesh. Calves in slightly thin to moderate flesh. High heat and low humidity is playing on like a broken record. Slaughter cows 2.00 higher. Slaughter bulls steady. Demand good for slaughter and country cows. Country buyers fairly aggressive for cows destined for greener pastures north of Oklahoma. Total of 865 cows and bulls sold with 70 percent to packers. Receipts this week 10,180; last week 10,430; last year 12,632. Supply consisted of 74 percent yearlings over 600 lbs;

18 percent calves under 600 lbs; 8 percent cows and bulls. Prices follow with weighed average weight and price in parenthesis.
