

Fortunate Fairgoer Finds \$31,827 At The Maryland State Fair

Last year, one fortunate Maryland State Fair visitor walked up to the Maryland State Comptroller's Unclaimed Property Booth and walked away with the knowledge that he was owed and would receive \$31,827 in unclaimed stock proceeds. This year, the Unclaimed Property Booth will return to the State Fair from Saturday, Aug. 29 to Monday, Sept. 7, 1998 from 10 a.m.-10 p.m. in the Exhibition Hall.

State Comptroller Louis L.

Goldstein's representatives will be on hand with computer hookups that allow fairgoers to enter their names and find out if they are the owners of unclaimed funds being held by the state. In 1997 alone, out of the 12,652 fairgoers who entered their names, 870 found leads on more than checks, and other monies.

"Our office has records on approximately 265,000 accounts worth more than \$92 million that have been reported to us over the past 30 years. Maryland's law is custodial, meaning that there is no time limit under which the property or its monetary equivalent may be claimed. You or your legitimate heirs may claim the funds at any time."

The unclaimed property booth is iust one of the many ways in which the Comptroller's Office attempts to locate rightful owners.


