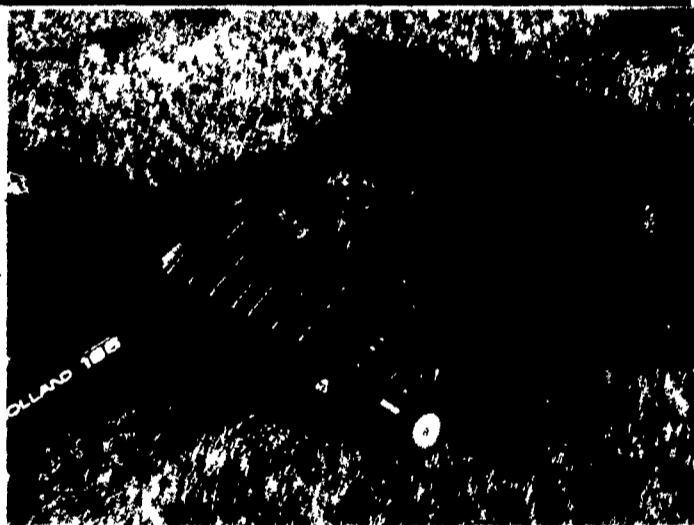
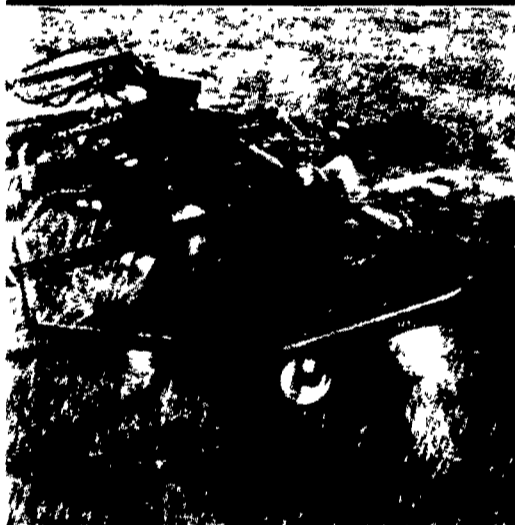

FASTER DRYING



When you're ready to make hay, you may face a race against bad weather. A New Holland tedder helps improve your odds. Tedding "fluffs" your crop by distributing it evenly to speed drying. Air flows through it, not just over it, so you can bale sooner - before it rains.

The Model 163 tedder features four rotors to cover an expanded 16'5" width, yet folds to a width of 9'6" to maneuver easily through gates or narrow roadways.

Making hay is often a race against the weather. A New Holland Model 166 windrow inverter gives you the edge you need to dry hay fast - before a storm hits. The Model 166 gently lifts, fluffs and turns windrows without roughing up the hay. Keeping more of the protein-rich leaves intact means you put higher quality hay into the bale or silo.

Fast recovery after the storm

If a storm does hit without warning and your field is wet, use the Model 166 to quickly move windrows onto dry ground. As the windrows are moved, they are fluffed and turned, allowing air to circulate through the hay exposing the wet underside to the sun and wind to speed drying time.
