Carroll County 4-H/FFA Livestock Sale Grosses \$130,000

WESTMINSTER, Md. - A total of 211 animals grossed over \$130,000 at the recent 1998 Carroll County 4-H/FFA fundraising livestock sale.

The sale is held each year in conjunction with the 4-H/FFA fair at the ag center. Auctioneers for the event were Nevin Tasto and Andy Cashman

Seventy-five market hogs went through the sale ring for an average of \$2.13 per pound.

The grand champion hog, a 260-pound crossbred gilt owned by 14-year-old Ashley Vosloh of Mt. Airy brought \$4 per pound from Jim Clark, T.J.'s Farm of Mt. Airy.

The reserve grand champion market hog, owned by 18-yearold- Heather Arnold of Union Bridge, was a crossbred barrow. Weighing in at 230 pounds, the hog was purchased by Lin Lar's PTL Acres, Woodbine, for \$2.10 per pound.

There were tow fund-raiser hogs, raised by 4-Hers, sold at the sale, with the proceeds earmarked for the ag center building fund.

The Feeser Family Hog was raised by 16-year-old Tim Cole, Manchester Tim's 220-pound crossbred barrow brought \$3.50 per pound from Reifsnider Vet and Farm Supply of Keymar.

The Fogle Septic Hog was raised by 12-year-old Tim Owings, of Manchester. The 260pound crossbred barrow was purchased by Flemings Bros. Inc. of Hampstead for \$1.90 per pound.

Steers averaged 97 cents per pound on 58 lots.


