THE LEON AND HILDA CUSHWA
AUCTION

We have been chosen to sell at auction the entire contents of Walnut Hill, the old stone farmhouse of Mr and Mrs. Leon Cushwa of Clear Spring, Maryland who have taken residence in an extended care facility Mrs. Cushwa-Hilda Frantz Cushwa - is the granddaughter of Emanuel Frantz, a well-known cabinetmaker and undertaker of Clear Spring who had learned his trade under the apprenticeship of James Dorrance and had married his daughter in 1856. James Dorrance, who had been handcrafting furniture in Clear Spring since the 1830s, moved to Lisbon, Ohio in 1872, leaving the business in the capable hands of his son-in-law. Mrs. Cushwa is the daughter of Emanuel Frantz's son, William - also a cabinetmaker - and she married cabinetmaker Leon Cushwa, so this auction will include various hand-crafted pieces from three generations of local furniture makers

There is also some very desirable original art, including various paintings by Baltimore artist and inventor Oliver Tarbell Eddy, whose works are presently in the permanent collections of the Baltimore Museum of Art, the Maryland Historical Society, The Newark Museum and the Frick Art Reference Library; and a large engraving of President Grant by George Frederick Cumming Smillie, with autograph. Smillie should probably be the most famous artist in America, for it was Smillie who, 1918, engraved the famous portrait of George Washington that is still used on the one dollar bill.

Also included are some unusual items from Lynnwood Manor, a Howard County mansion formerly owned by James C. Adams, Sr., an ancestor of Mrs Cushwa An abbreviated list of items to be sold include: a museum-quality Portsmouth Federal secretary, circa 1800; very unusual Victorian bedroom suite, with hand-carved detailing (the bow front dresser has marble top and the bed was custom-made in oversize), walnut corner cupboard made by Leon Cushwa, of walnut lumber, cut and dried from Walnut Hill Farm, 80" tall, Civil War period spool-turned armchair from the Adams family; early Hitchcock-style settee, a family piece, possibly Dorrance, and restored by William Frantz, (2) cherry tilt-top tables, both with bird cage, one made by William Frantz, walnut secretary desk, with paneled doors, made by Emanuel Frantz; Georgian stick barometer and early mahogany tea caddy, both passed down through the Cushwa family; yarn winder, walnut card table, dining table and chairs, table was in Lynnwood Manor during the Civil War; marble-top sideboard, with burl fronts and hand-carved motif, passed down through the Adams family, walnut-finished jelly cupboard, fine European gold-leaf mirror,

with marble-top wall shelf, a Hardesty piece, through the Cushwa family, mahogany armoire, with beveled mirror and birds-eye maple interior, one of several; bookcase, with glass doors, various footstools, several small walnut wall curio shelves; carved breadboard; butterprint carving, small cane collection, including one owned by the famous author Irvin S. Cobb; equipment from the original Frantz cabinetmakers' shop, including a workbench, large mortise machine, wooden clamps and planes and various tools, set of branding irons from the old Seibert Distillery, used to mark the wooden barrels, (2) rare 1876 Centennial bandannas, a selection of various-sized oil lamps, dishes and glassware, including examples of pattern, pressed, Willow, Nippon, Noritake, German, Haviland-Limoges, handpainted and ironstone, carte-de-visite album, dated 1864; large Daguerreotype of the Adams family, several old cameras, old binoculars; miscellaneous kitchenware; lots of picture frames, old trombone; advertising thermometer and several rugs.

Lots of books, including a rare first edition of "Ben Hur," by General Lew Wallace, an 1869 German ABC book, the Frantz family Bible; some very desirable books on local history, including the rare original editions of Scharf's History of Western Maryland, Williams History of Washington County and the 1877 Illustrated Atlas of Washington County; various early letters of documents, 1840s-1860s original edger of the Adams Meat Processing Co.; pre-Civil War letters from the U S Government to James C. Adams, Co. discussing meat purchases for the Army and Navy, letter dated 1866 from the office of Godey's magazine to Mr Eddy requesting an immediate shipment of his famous ink and much more that was not listed.
