

Winners Announced At Va. Angus Breeders' Show

Pasture Walk Sept. 10

FREDERICK, Md. - An afternoon pasture walk is planned for Thursday, Sept. 10 from 10 a.m.-noon at Bob and Cindy Harrington's Dairy Farm at 5816E Jefferson Pike in Frederick. The Harrington's farm is in its fifth year of grazing, and it includes 30 cows and 40 heifers on 120 acres.

Pasture walks allow livestock producers a chance to learn more about using rotational grazing to increase agricultural profitability. Most of the time will be spent walking through the pastures and discussing grass and clover growth, fencing, and watering systems.

To reach the farm from the 15/340 exit in Frederick, go west on Jefferson Pike 1.5 miles. Turn right onto the first lane immediately before the Stoney Creek development. Follow the signs to the farm.

From Mt. Zion Road, go east on Jefferson Pike 1.1 miles. Turn left onto the second lane after the Stoney Creek development. Follow signs to the farm.




