Board Announces Yield Contest

LANDISVILLE (Lancaster Co.) — Pennsylvania's annual Soybean Yield Contest has some great prizes in store for top growers, including paid round-trip air fare and lodging for two in February in Albuquerque, New Mexico for the first place winner.

Second place winner receives \$500 in cash and third, \$250 cash.

How do you enter? Growers eligible include those in Pennsylvania who produce five acres or more of soybeans. The soybeans must be grown in Pennsylvania.

Participants must use nonirrigated soybeans. But they're not

restricted to variety, fertilization, spacing, or other cultural practices.

To participate, send a request for application with your name, address, and phone number to the Pennsylvania Soybean Yield Contest, Attention of John Yocum, P.O. Box 308, Landisville, PA 17538 no later than Sept. 15, 1998.

Three acres in one block must be selected by the grower and can be measured after harvest. A designated representative (other than grower) must measure the test area, be present when the test area is harvested, supervise weighing on scales, and sign a report. Only one entry per farm will be accepted and there is no charge for participation. Acre yields will be calculated on the basis of 13 percent moisture.

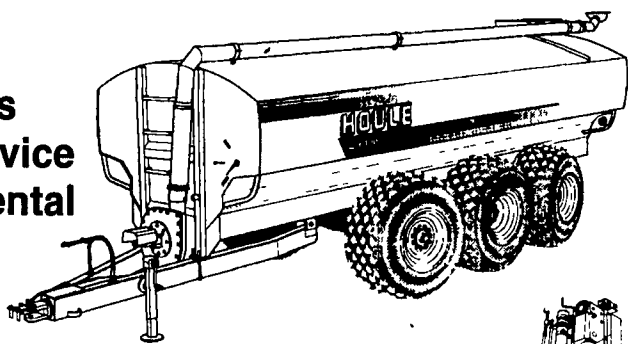
Production practices used by participants producing 60 bushels or more per acre will be publicized at the time county and state winners are announced.



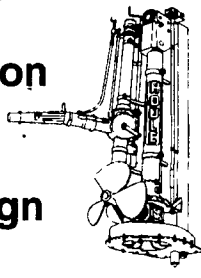
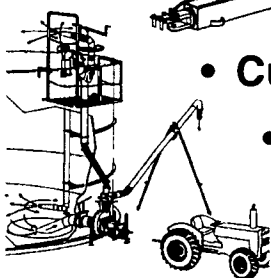
