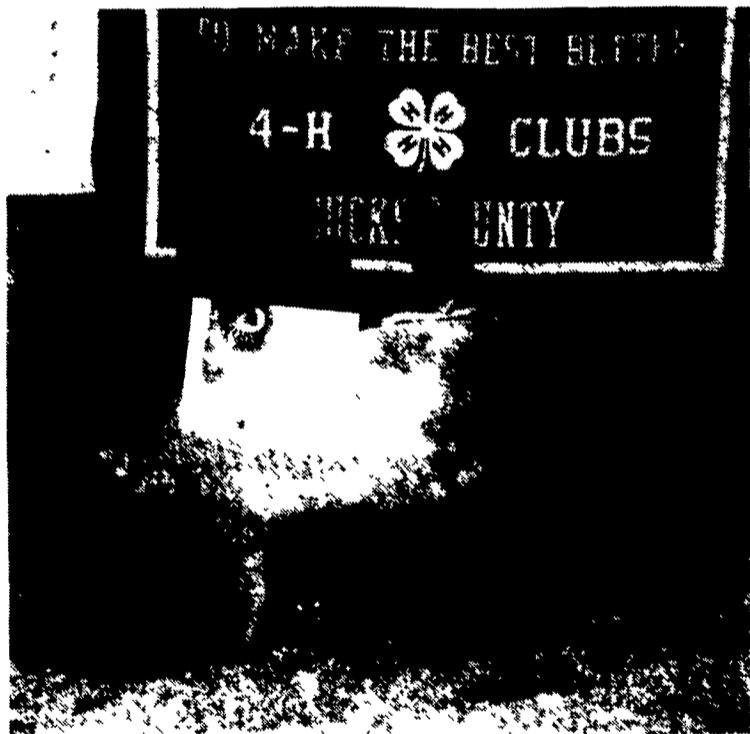
Overall, 42 market hogs were shown and averaged \$.60 per pound at the sale.
