The pressure was evident on the lesser quality cattle as buyers were conservative on the verge of the holiday weekend. A light test of Holstein steers were 50-1.00 lower and slaughter heifers were not well tested. A good offering of slaughter cows sold weak to .50 lower and slaughter bulls were fully steady. Supply included 30 percent slaughter steers and 39 percent slaughter cows.


