Packers were the dominant buyers, again this week, with added demand from nearby holidays. Around 66 percent of supply was sold for slaughter. All pigs weighed on arrival and sold by the hundred weight.

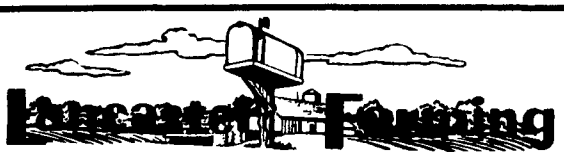
