

# Scholars Complete Youth Institute

SHIPPENSBURG (Franklin Co.) — Six scholars from the Lancaster Council of Pennsylvania Council of Cooperatives (PCC) recently completed a four-day Youth Institute at Shippensburg University.

In attendance were Beth Frey of Millersville, Paul Hostetter of Holtwood, Bob Karr of Millersville, Brandon Martin of Ephrata, Sara McMullen of Conestoga, and

Ryan Martin of Ephrata. Carol Fay, vo ag teacher from Penn Manor School District, and Lehman Metzler, vo ag teacher from Lancaster Mennonite High School, accompanied the Lancaster delegation to Shippensburg and served as chaperones and adult resource leaders.

The 1998 Summer Youth Institute was the 38th in a series that began in 1960. It was designed to

enhance scholars' understanding and appreciation of cooperatives, issues of concern to cooperatives, and develop leadership skills.

Scholars were sponsored to the institute by local and regional cooperatives operating in the Lancaster County area.

The Summer Institute is a joint effort of PCC and the Penn State Cooperative Business Education and Research Program (CBERP).

Local scholars were joined by more than 60 scholars and adult resource leaders.

In addition to cooperative basics and planned leadership building activities, scholars "faced" the issues of globalization, presented by Chuck Cruickshank of Land O'Lakes, and biotechnology and the ethics of science, presented by Lindy Brigham, a post-doctoral fellow in

Penn State's Department of Plant Pathology.

A highlight of the Institute each year is the awards luncheon. Eleven scholars, including Beth Frey (chosen as one of two PCC ambassadors), and Ryan Martin of the Lancaster Council, earned scholarships to attend the National Institute on Cooperative Education (NICE) in Anaheim, Calif., in August.

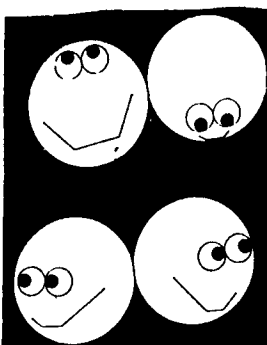
