There were two junior-aged animals in the show, both exhibited by Shannon. Her senior calf was named junior champion and her junior calf was reserve junior champion.

In the Guernsey breed, Karen Sterner exhibited all the champions. Her grand champion was a 3-year-old, Liseter Victor's Hillory; while her reserve grand champion was an aged cow, Amber-Knoll Valerie Ember. Her junior champion was a senior calf, Amber-Knoll Jos Gallant Jill.

In showmanship, Jill Neiman was grand champion of the 4-H division, while older sister Jennifer was grand champion of the agricultural education division (FFA & Vo-Ag).

This year, for the first time, an overall grand champion showman was selected in order to compete again showmanship champions from all livestock species exhibited at Allentown. The supreme champion showman is to be selected during a contest scheduled to be held tomorrow, Sept. 6.
