





Food Sanitation Course

STROUDSBURG (Monroe Co.) — Penn State Cooperative Extension will be offering Serv-Safe, a training and certification program for foodservice personnel October 13, 20, 27, and November 3 at the Monroe County Office, Route 611, Stroudsburg.

The course will begin at 9 a.m. each day, and end at 4:30. Cost is \$85 including the textbook, handouts, a pocket thermometer, and beverage breaks. The class requires reading of the textbook and independent study. On November 3, the National Restaurant Association certification exam will be given. Those who pass will receive a certificate from the Educational Foundation of the National Restaurant Association, as a certified food handler.

The 120-pound crossbred, grand champion lamb of Heidi Svonavec, Rockwood, at \$10 a pound, brought \$1,200 from Animal Medical Center of Somerset County

Nicole Shultz's 122-pound, reserve champion Suffolk bought by Swank's Steel City Shows, brought \$671 or \$5 50 a pound. Shultz is from Rockwood

Lucas Svonavec had the champion home grown lamb bought at \$650 a pound or \$786.50 by Yachere Mobile Feeds

Lindsey Schmuck's home grown reserve champion lamb was bought by Lost Run Lodge for \$669 50, or \$6.50 a pound

Schmuck is from Rockwood

Gabriel Svonavec, Rockwood had the Carcass Lamb champion which sold for \$2 a pound to Supply Co Sheesley Johnstown

Charles Smith, Rockwood

showed the grand champion market swine, a Hampshire cross weighing 240 pounds It was bought by First Philson Bank N A for \$1 320, or \$5 50 per pound.

The reserve champion swine, a 261-pound Blue Butt shown by Brock Hillegass, Fairhope, sold for \$4.20 per pound, or \$1,096 20 The buyer was Somerset County 4-H and FFA Scholarship Fund

Also awarded during the sale were the 4-H scholarships to Ryan Schmuck, Amy Schmuck, Heidi Svonavec, Sara Hillegas, and Gretchen Fox

Statistician Doyle Paul observed that about 400 buyers were enthusiastic and gave good prices throughout, accounted for the averages of \$121 per pound for the beef; \$2.26 for lambs, and \$1.54 for the swine


