 Compared to last week: Feeder steers 2.00-3.00 higher. Steer calves steady to 4.00 higher. Feeder heifers and heifer calves 3.00-4.00 higher. Demand good for feeders, moderate for calves. Frances delivered appreciable rainfall to eastern Oklahoma with token amount to central Oklahoma but neglected the west. The general weather pattern is improving with hopes of more rain to assist in breaking drought conditions. Quality average. Feeder cattle in medium flesh. Calves in medium to fleshy conditions. Weigh-ups average to full. Slaughter cows uneven. Lean cows 1.00 lower; boners and breakers lean cows; good for large cows. Total of 1,375 cows and bulls sold with 70 percent to packers. Receipts this week 12,203; last week 3,485; last year 11,692. Supply consisted of 63 percent yearlings and few calves over 600 lbs; 26 percent calves under 600 lbs; 11 percent cows and bulls. Prices follow with weighted average weight and price in parenthesis.

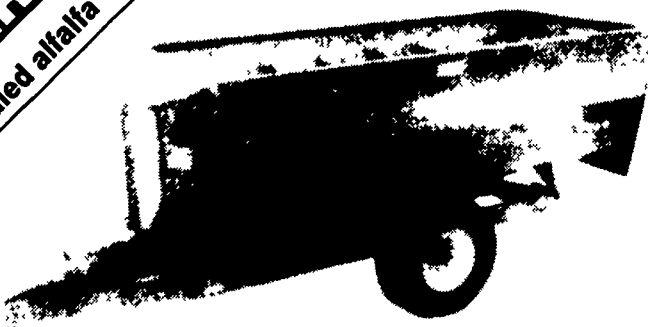

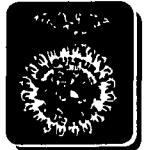
