



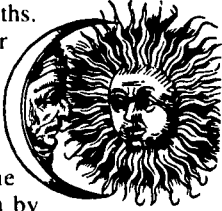

AUTUMNAL EQUINOX

September 23 at 1:37 A.M., Eastern Daylight Time, marks this year's passing of summer into fall. It's said that as the wind and weather are at the time of the equinoxes, so will be the wind and weather generally during the following three months.

If the autumn is warm, the winter is reputed to be long. If there's much autumn fog, there will be much winter snow. If the autumn is clear, the winter will be windy. If the leaves on the deciduous trees have not fallen by St. Martin's Day (November 11), expect a cold winter. If the storms of September clear off warm, however, you can expect the winter storms to be relatively warm, as well.

The autumn night is changeable. - Norwegian proverb

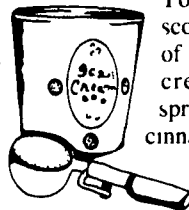
TIP OF THE WEEK

Instead of leaf bags or garbage cans, use a large, discarded sheet or tarp to gather up leaves.

BAKED APPLES & CHUTNEY

- 6 'Granny Smith' or other tart baking apples
- 3/4 cup mango (or other) chutney
- 1 pint good-quality vanilla ice cream
- cinnamon, to taste

apple with chutney. Place into a baking pan with 1/2 inch of water. Bake about 45 minutes, until apples are just soft. Remove from oven and let cool. Top with a scoop or two of vanilla ice cream and sprinkle with cinnamon.



Makes 6 servings.

Preheat oven to 400° F. Rinse, core, and cut off the tops of the apples, but leave a bit of the bottom core intact to seal in the chutney. Fill each
