CATTLE: Compared to Tuesday, slaughter steers sold steady to firm. Buyers were fairly active but the quality was somewhat lacking with as many Select cattle on hand as anything else. A good offering of Holstein steers sold .50 to mostly 1.00 higher and slaughter heifers were steady in a light test. Slaughter cow trading was mixed; the leaner cows sold weak to

.50 lower, while the fleshier cows (less than 85 percent lean) were .50 higher. Slaughter bulls sold steady. Supply included 36 percent slaughter steers and 37 percent slaughter cows.

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
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
