USDA, EPA Propose A Plan

may evolve and change as their understanding of the issues increases through further work and receipt of additional information."

The table of contents provides an introduction and guiding principles; a section on AFOs and what characterizes them and the risks to water quality and public health; a section on the national goal and performance expectations of AFOs; the relationship between voluntary and mandatory programs, stressing that most are to be voluntary; and strategic issues, which effectively are the theoretical ways to implement the strategy.

According to the draft strategy, "AFOs are agricultural enterprises where animals are kept and raise in confined situations."

Further, it states that USDA data indicates that majority of farms with livestock are considered small — with fewer than 250 animal units. Animal units are described as "roughly one beef cow, therefore 1,000 AUs is equal to 1,000 beef cows or equivalent number of other animals."

Those operations with 1,000 AUs or more are considered large operations.

1992" the number of livestock has increased by about 3 percent. "During the same period, however, the number of AFOs decreased, indicating a consolidation within the industry overall and greater production from fewer and larger AFOs."

According to the proposal's statement of the national goal and performance expectations of AFOs, "USDA and EPA's goal is for AFO owners and operators to take actions to minimize water pollution from confinement facilities and land application of manure. To accomplish this goal, this strategy establishes a national performance expectation that all AFOs should develop and implement technically sound and economically feasible Comprehensive Nutrient Management Plans (CNMPs) to minimize impacts on water quality and public health."

The proposal would have the Natural Resources Conservation Service (NRCS) Field Office Technical Guide (FOTG) is the primary technical reference to be used for developing the nutrient management plans.

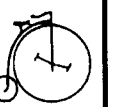
