HOLSTEIN STEER PRICES WERE STEADY TO 50 LOWER THE LIGHT OFFERING OF SLAUGHTER COWS WAS NOT ENOUGH TO TEST PRICES BUT A LOWER UNDERTONE WAS EVIDENT SLAUGHTER BULL TRADE WAS SLOW AND MOSTLY 100 LOWER SUPPLY INCLUDED 65 PERCENT SLAUGHTER STEERS AND 13 PER-CENT COWS

Buyers were very price conscious and did not seem to be impressed by the high quality types, as premiums were very rare. Holstein steers were weak to .50 lower and the light test of slaughter heifers sold mostly 1.00 lower. Slaughter cows sold .50- 1.00 lower and slaughter bull prices were 1.00-3.00 lower. Supply included 44 percent slaughter steers and 33 percent slaughter cows.
