

Indiana County Fair Jr. Livestock Sale

 INDIANA (Indiana Co.) — More than 200 head of livestock were sold at the annual 4-H and FFA junior livestock sale on Friday, Sept. 4 at the Indiana County Fair.

The 112 buyers paid a total of \$96,152.98 for the 121 swine, 65 lambs and 28 steers. Many of the animals were ribbon-win-

ners from 4-H and FFA competitions earlier in the week. The buyers, exhibitors and prices with total prices in parentheses, for some of the top animals were as follows:

Giant Eagle Market bought Tim Bishop's grand champion market steer for \$2.75 per pound (\$3,327.50).

Hoss's Steak and Sea House bought Amy Martin's reserve

champion market steer for \$2.30 per pound (\$2,725.50). The steer was then donated to the Red Cross for resale, and was sold the second time to T.J.'s Mining for \$1.05 per pound (\$1,244.25).

Elderton State Bank bought Joseph Abel's grand champion steer carcass for \$3.00 per pound (\$2,031.00).

Saltsburg Shop & Save bought Luke States' reserve champion steer carcass for \$3.40 per pound (\$1,985.00)

Elkin Manufacturing bought Patrick Ackerson's grand champion county-bred steer for \$1.00 per pound (\$1,162.00).

Custom Fab Trailers bought Sarah Sweigart's grand champion market hog for \$5.25 per pound (\$1,233.75)

William G. Satterlee & Sons bought Scot Martin's reserve champion market hog for \$4.25 (\$1,062.50).

Luther Ford Sales bought Carl Catalano's grand champion pork carcass for \$3.75 per pound (\$768.75)

McNess dealers Robert and Michael Orr bought Barry Blose's reserve champion pork carcass for \$3.25 per pound (\$555.75).

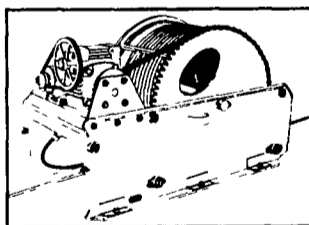

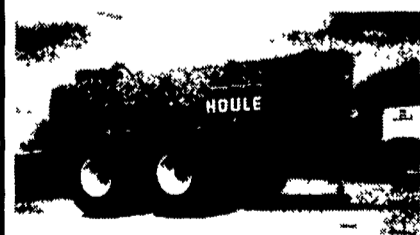

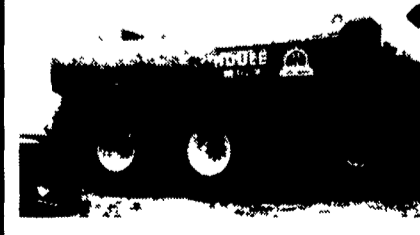
