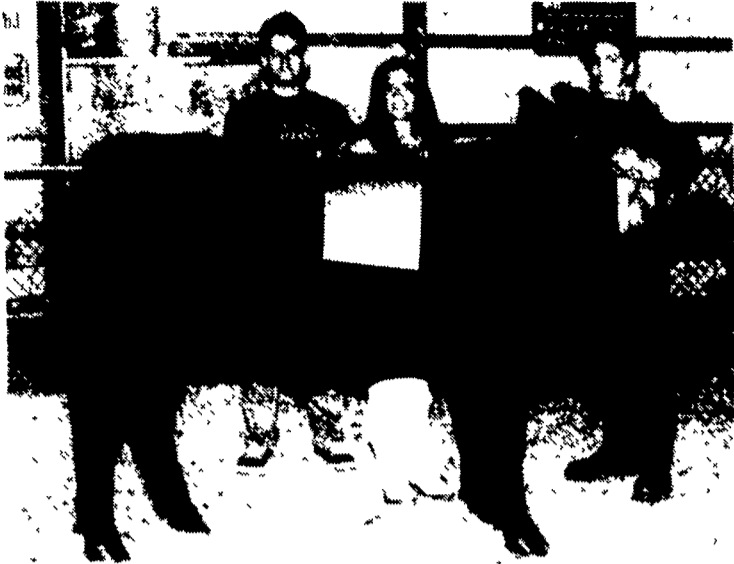


Lampeter Market Steer Brings \$2,700
