HOLSTEIN STEER PRICES WERE FULLY STEADY A LIMITED SUPPLY OF SLAUGHTER COWS AND BULLS TRADED NEAR STEADY. SUPPLY INCLUDED 56 PERCENT SLAUGH-TER STEERS AND 18 PERCENT SLAUGHTER COWS.



For the week, prices ended 1.00-1.50 higher with moderate premiums and discounts applied to the fancy and plainer individuals respectively. Holstein steer prices were fully steady and a limited test of slaughter heifers sold steady to 1.00 higher. Slaughter cows and bulls traded mostly steady to firm. Supply included 39 percent slaughter steers and 39 percent slaughter cows.




