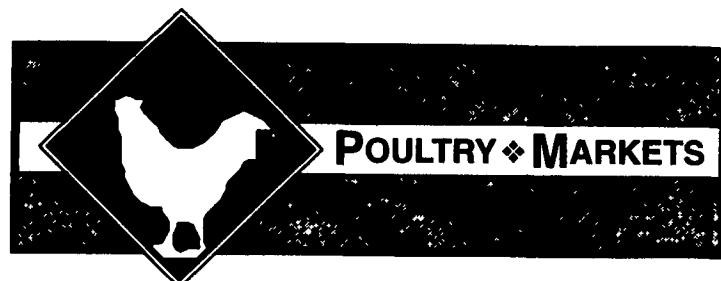

adequate on the balance. Breaking stock

usually adequate, and demand was spotty  
for confidently offered extra eggs. Light  
type hen supplies remained adequate for  
full plant schedules.
