Slaughter heifers mostly steady, with several Holsteins included. Slaughter cows uneven, fleshy kinds weak to 50 lower with leaner kinds 1.00- 2.00 lower. Bulls 1.00-2.00 lower, with some 1850-2250 lbs fully 5.00 lower. Supply included 42 percent slaughter steers and 35 percent cows.

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
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
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
