In a very close contest, selected by the score of the sixth class, reserve champion was "Meadow Creek Jake," a Percheron owned and ridden by Carolyn Loucks, Reedsville. Placing sixth in last year's Challenge, "Jake" has been in the contest for the last three years. He won the first ever Western and English Draft horse under saddle held at KILE, and won the first ever draft Under saddle at the Pennsylvania Farm Show.
