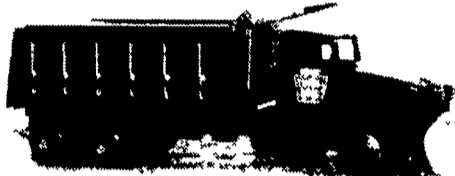

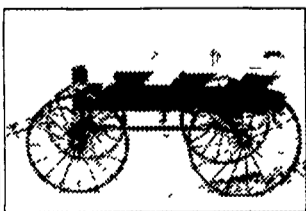

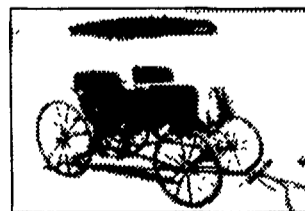

Horse Drawn Steam Fire Pumper By the LaFrance Fire Engine Co.



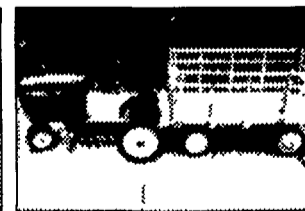
