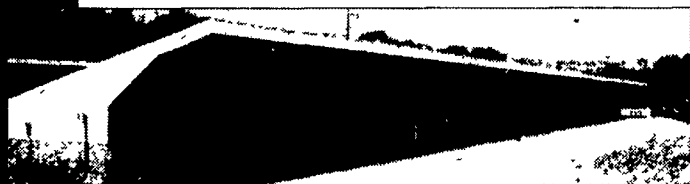
At the Eastern States Exposition the team placed third in Jerseys, fourth in Guernseys and fifth in Ayrshires, Holsteins and overall. Pavelski was sixth in Milking Shorthorns, Haas was fifth in Jerseys, Oberholtzer was seventh in Holsteins and ninth in Ayrshires, and Glock was eighth in Brown Swiss, sixth in Guernseys, third in Jerseys and sixth overall.

At the Pennsylvania All-American Contest, the team placed ninth overall and third in Holsteins. Haas placed third in Jerseys. In the National Intercollegiate Contest in Madison they placed tenth overall and were in the top 10 for three breeds. It was the sixth consecutive year Penn State was in the top 10 teams.
