CATTLE: Compared to last week's closing prices, the slaughter steer and heifer market fell progressively lower this week to close 1.00-1.50 lower. Cattle prices fell victim to decreased demand due to next week's Thanksgiving holiday and continued pressure from obscene hog prices. Futures prices led the drop on Monday by opening the week limit-down, following last week's cattle-on-feed report which was judged to be bearish by analysts. The Western direct trade lost mostly

2.00 this week and closed at 61.00 live and 97.00 dressed. Local Holstein steers ended the week .50-1.00 lower in a light test. A good week's offering of slaughter cows sold .50-1.00 higher, while slaughter bulls ended 1.00-2.00 lower with late week losses. Supply was made up of around 30 percent slaughter steers, 7 percent slaughter heifers, 40 percent slaughter cows, 6 percent bulls, with the balance feeders.
