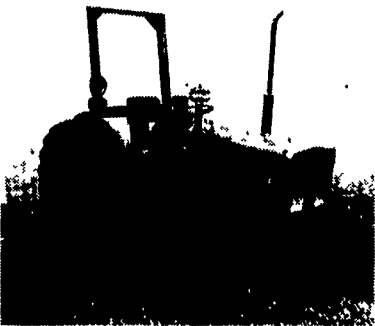
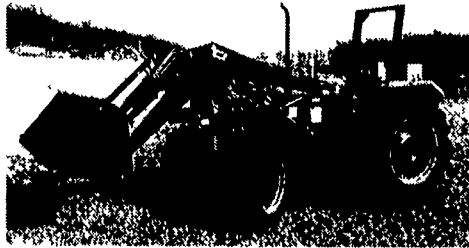

Oklahoma National Stockyards - Weekly Cattle Summary
Compared to last week: Steer and heifer calves steady to 2.00 higher. Calf demand good as warm fall weather is allowing excellent wheat growth. Limited test of feeder steers and heifers steady. Feeder demand good. Bulk supply continues to be calves. Slaughter cows and bulls steady. Packer demand moderate. Country buyers aggressive for bred cows and grazers. 530 cows and bulls sold with 45 percent to packers. Receipts this week 6,350; last week 16,443; last year 8,794. Supply consisted of 40 percent yearlings and calves over 600 lbs; 52 percent calves under 600 lbs; 8 percent cows and bulls. Prices follow with weighted average weight and price in parenthesis.

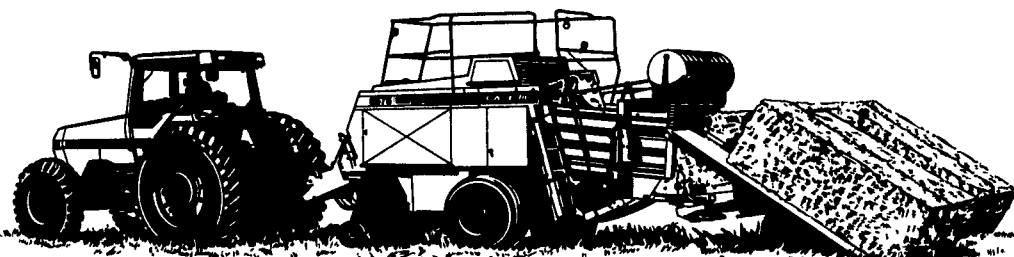

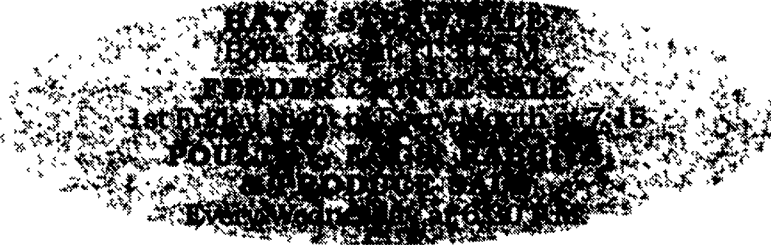
