Supply included some of the fanciest steers seen in several weeks and most all of the market's strength was placed on those types. Holstein steer prices were steady to .50 higher and a light test of heifers sold steady to 1.00 higher. A large offering of slaughter cows traded mostly .50 lower and slaughter buils sold fully steady. Supply included 26 percent slaughter steers and 53

percent slaughter cows.

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
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
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
