## **Adams County Composting Program Under Review**

Adams County Correspondent ADAMS COUNTY — Mother Nature's been doing it for years — and so have farmers and gardeners.

Now comes a way to speed up

this natural process that could possibly make manure and other vegetable matter a money producer for farmers.

The process is composting, a popular method of turning manure and vegetable waste

into a beneficial product.

Recently David D. Koun Jr., Adams County Chesapeake Bay Program nutrient management specialist along with John Caffrey, a New Jersey businessman, brought a portable labora-



tory model of a mechanical composter to Adams County. In a joint effort with the local Conservation district they placed the composter — or digester as some call it — on several farms for a few days so that farmers could see it in a field operation. While this model was not automated, most would be, Caffrey said.

Caffrey's company worked with Texas A&M to develop the digester which can go from site to site—to farms, food processors and sewage plants and potentially lower disposal coats.

After its stay in Adams County, the composter was going to Penn State where it was to be used experimentally in the disposal of sewage and farm waste, and possibly vegetative waste from the cafeteria.

He noted proposed changes to composting regulations make the digester a valuable tool for



we believe is the cheapest solution to a lot of their problems. Since an \$18,000 unit will take care of the waste of up to 50 dairy cattle per day."

And, some compost can be used as a feed supplement, he said.

Kann added that he officially responded to the Animal Feeding **Operations** Strategy (AFO), a joint proposal the US. of Department of Agriculture (USDA) the U.S. and Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) to follow a strategy to use interpretations of existing authorities and programs to get all livestock farmers to adopt comprehensive nutrient management plans.

In his response to AFO he expressed concern "That we're getting into an area that is dangerous and costly to the farmer who does not have the option to pass the buck."
